

## Girls Education

In 2016-17, a total of 90,59,312 Children have been enrolled in Primary and Upper Primary sections, out of which 55,38,880 children have been enrolled in Primary sections and 35,20,432 have been enrolled in Upper Primary sections. In Primary, the percentage of enrolment of boys and girls is 52.87 % and 47.12% respectively. At Upper Primary level, the percentage of boys and girls is 54.28% and 45.71% respectively. If both primary and upper primary sections are taken into consideration, the enrolment of boys and girls in terms of percentage has been 53.42 and 46.57% respectively, which indicates the prevailing positive gender parity in enrolment in the State. The following figure indicates the same.

**Separate Girls Toilets:** State was sanctioned 1295 separate girl's toilets up to 2016-17. Out of it, 1227 are completed and 68 in progress will be completed before Jan-17.

### Gender Audit:

The checklist to assess gender responsive teaching and learning environment in schools (gender audit) was prepared by SSA. The checklist consists of different indicators; the checklist was shared with all the District Girls Education Coordinators (DGCs), Block & Cluster Resource Coordinators.

The indicators in the checklist were divided into three main aspects;

- (A) School and classroom physical environment
- (B) School and classroom learning environment
- (C) Teacher-child interaction and pedagogy

The gender audit was conducted in 28780 schools across the state. Major findings are separated and for follow up work & training needs were identified for creating gender bias free classrooms/school environment considering the findings. Further district will do gender audit independently to focus gender sensitization in all schools of the particular district.

### **"Meena ni Duniya" Radio programme**

*Meena ni Duniya* radio Program is implemented in 109 KGBVs and 223 Upper primary school of Educationally Backward Blocks of Dist. Banaskantha-Deodar, Dist. Rajkot-Jasdan and Dist. Surat-Umarpada with the support from UNICEF. This programme is started as pilot base from July-2016. This programme is broad-casted from All India Radio 3(three) days (Monday, Wednesday and Friday) in a week after assembly. The subject of the episode includes gender equality, Inclusion, RTE, Child friendly Schools, WASH & Child rights.

### **Celebration of Republic day - "Dikrini Salam Deshne Nam"**

State is celebrating Republic day in different way. On that day flag hoisting is done by most educated girl of that village and mothers are welcomed and given first raw in the program who deliver girl child in that year to promote "*Beti Bachao Beti Padhao*" programme

### Progress KGBV 2016-17

- State has operationalized all 89 KGBVs sanctioned up to 2016-17. Of these 39 is Model I, 25 Model II and 25 are Model III enrolling 6559 girls against 6600 targeted enrolment
- Remaining 8 KGBV buildings are completed in the current year since June - 16. So all KGBV buildings are completed.
- Current enrolment is 99.40% against the targeted enrolment.

- Activities like Glass painting, to make west to best items, Gardening, Meena Radio Program, Weekly Exposure visit.

- Documented KGBV girls Success stories named “*Sapanani Udan*” and KGBV teachers case study who is strongest root of KGBV named “ KGBV Teachers”
- Developed CD on the subject of “Quality education and Green KGBV”

### **State Initiatives to improve performance of KGBVs:**

#### **1. OMR based learning Assessment:**

- OMR based learning Assessment of every KGBV girls have been done by District level.
- Subject wise Question papers were prepared by District Diet Authority.
- Super Vision & Monitoring have been done by BRCs and CRCs Coordinator.
- OMR checked and Result prepared by Diet or subject specific BRPs.

#### **2. Meena Radio Program:**

Meena Radio Program implemented in 109 KGBVs. 40 Episode have been selected by Core team. Episode broadcasted through All India Radio (AIR) as per the Calendar created by the Core Team. After completing episode broadcasting teachers discuss with children about episode story, motive, values etc.

#### **3. Green KGBV**

Green KGBVs project have been implemented in 100 KGBVs (including GOG KGBVs) in the Year 2015-16.

- The Green School Programme has been rewarded with the highest Independent honor in Education Department at National Level as SKOCH PLATINUM AWARD on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 at Hyderabad.
- The KGBVs are under the rating system by IGBC (Indian Green Building Council) and one of the KGBV in Gandhinagar district is certified for IGBC GREEN SCHOOLS GOLD.
