2) National Programme for Education of Girls at Elementary level (NPEGEL)

- NPEGEL is a has been formulated for education of under privileged/ disadvantaged girls from class I to VIII as a separate and distinct gender component plan of SSA.
- In Gujarat, NPEGEL is implemented in 78 rural EBBs and 11 selected urban sums, which total covers 1584 clusters; out of which 1146 Model cluster schools (MCS) are established. 12, 48,165 girls are benefiting.
- MCS are selected at district level and block level based on achievement in girls' enrolment, retention and quality education in individual school.
- Each cluster has 1MCS for girl-child friendly activities.

- MCS have the facilities of an additional classroom, electrification, water and toilet facility.
- MCS activities in 2012-13 includes;
